The Council of the City of Willard met in regular session on Monday, November 19, 2018 with the Council President calling the meeting to order. The meeting was opened with prayer by Chaplain Sherry Patterson, Salvation Army.

ROLL CALL: Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig present.

MINUTES:

Minutes of the Regular Council meeting held on November 5, 2018 were presented for approval. In that copies of these minutes were furnished to each Council person prior to the meeting, there was no request they be read. Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Gerber that minutes be approved as received. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. Motion carried.

1. **Appropriations for 2018** - Each Council person had previously received a copy of the 2019 Appropriations Budget in their packets. President requested a motion to set Public Hearing for the budget. Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Olson that Public Hearing for budget be set for Monday, December 3rd at 7:30 p.m. at the next regular Council meeting. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. Motion carried.

1. **Letter from Department of Commerce, Div. of Liquor Control**, notifying us that all permits to sell alcoholic beverages in our political subdivision will expire on February 1, 2019. We have the right to object to the renewal of any of the permits and request a hearing. All objections must be received by January 2, 2019. President requested a motion to accept communication and place on file. Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Olson letter be accepted and placed on file. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. Motion carried.

REPORTS FROM OFFICERS: Finance Director reviewed her report for October. Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Olson that Finance report for October be accepted and placed on file. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. motion carried.

REPORT FROM CITY MANAGER:

City Manager reported that he talked with Police Chief in reference to renewal of liquor licenses. Chief Chaffins said they did not have any specific issues with any specific establishment. Lagoon is again empty.

Council requested to accept the following donations to benefit the Clock Tower project: \$500 check from an anonymous source, \$300 cash from Don and Shirley Leininger, \$100 cash from George Hiltbrunner, \$100 check from Todd Shiningar and the ROMEO'S, \$100 from Ken and Renee Steinmetz and \$200 from Laura Kahle.

Council requested to accept the following donation to benefit the Military Memorial Fund: \$1,000 check from Don Graham.

Council requested to accept the following donations to benefit the Police taser replacement project: \$127.07 from Willard Firelands Moose #2153.

Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Olson that these donations be accepted by Council. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. Motion carried.

President requested a motion to not request any hearings of the Div. of Liquor Control for permits. Moved by Elmlinger seconded by Olson that no hearings be requested for liquor permits. In a called vote, Danhoff, Daniel, Elmlinger, Gerber, Johnson, Olson and Sattig voted yea. Motion carried.

Elmlinger – asked what part the City played in getting Family Dollar’s parking lot fixed. City Manager said the only thing was we requested for a couple of years that they fix parking lot issue and then Engineer approved their plan.

Johnson – had some questions about removal of trees in boulevard on Myrtle Avenue and the playground equipment by the Depot. Could we possibly put something out again as to what is going on in these two locations. City Manager said maybe he could get with the Willard Times plus Facebook and/or our website.

Johnson – has there been any feedback on the new leaf machine. Johnson and a couple of others felt there have been some issues. City Manager said there have been some issues and there has been a learning curve for everyone. Crew is working on these things and we will know better next year.

Gerber – voiced concerns on the severity of the charges in the J turn legislation, would like to see it lessened.
