Parade trophies will be awarded in the following categories: *Most Unique, Most Participants, Best Queen Float, Best Float, Most Colorful, Most Patriotic, Historical Award* (most historic value), *Farthest Traveled Group, Best Marching Group, Best Baton Group, and Proud to Call Willard Home*. For stage performances, we will be awarding trophies for: *Best Performance and Most Unique Presentation*.
